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**AN ACT to Deem the Municipality of Jay to Be Part of the Northern  
Androscoggin District of the District Court.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. 4 MRSA, § 153, sub-§ 1, 2nd sentence**, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 559, is amended to read:

For the purpose of ~~criminal business solely~~ **this section**, the municipality of Jay, located in the County of Franklin, shall be deemed to be within the District of Northern Androscoggin.

**Sec. 2. 4 MRSA, § 153, sub-§ 10, first sentence**, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 35, is further amended to read:

Franklin consists of the entire County of Franklin **except the municipality of Jay.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act, by allowing Jay residents to conduct District Court business at Livermore Falls instead of Farmington, will save them needless travel and expense.
