STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning Graves of Revolutionary War Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine Society of the Sons of the American Revolution the sum of \$1,000 for the biennium 1975-77 to be used for locating, recording and marking graves of veterans of the American Revolution who were buried in Maine. The breakdown shall be as follows:
