STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse William Rich of Buckfield for Loss of Bee Hives by Bear.

William Rich; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$225 to be paid to William Rich of Buckfield as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of 5 bee hives destroyed by bear.

STATEMENT OF FACT

On April 24, 1973, Mr. William Rich of Buckfield lost 5 hives of bees containing 2 supers by bear in the Songo Pond area. Since this incident occurred prior to the effective date of Public Law 1973, chapter 776 which does not allow reimbursement retroactively, Mr. Rich's only recourse is this claim before the Legislature.
