## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Fee for Nonresident Big Game Hunting Permits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 12 MRSA, § 2401, sub-§ 3, ¶ F, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 276, is amended to read:
  - F. Nonresident big game hunting Permits hunting for all species including bear and deer.

#### FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that the annual increase in state revenue derived from passage of this Act will amount to \$1,750,000.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act, by increasing the fee for nonresident big game hunting licenses, will increase the revenue brought in by the licensing of hunters.
