SEVENTY-FIVE

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**AN ACT** Relating to Irreconcilable Marital Differences.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

19 MRSA, § 691, 2nd sentence, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 532, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to remove the requirement of counseling as a condition to receiving a divorce on the ground of irreconcilable differences.
