STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide Funds for an Additional Assistant District Attorney in Prosecutorial District 6.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 30 MRSA, § 554-A, sub-§ 6, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 567, § 19, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 6. The district attorney for Prosecutorial District 6 shall be allowed up to the sum of \$40,500 per year to be used for compensation of assistant district attorneys.
- 7. The district attorney for Prosecutorial District 7 shall be allowed up to the sum of \$27,000 per year to be used for compensation of assistant district attorneys.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$18,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will provide funds for the District Attorney of Prosecutorial District 6, which embraces Sagadahoc, Lincoln, Knox and Waldo Counties, to hire another full-time assistant district attorney at a salary of \$13,500 per year.
