COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 33,
L. D. 91, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment

Amend said Resolution by striking out in
the 1st and 2nd lines of the 4th paragraph (same
in L. D.) the underlined word "seventy-five"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined
word 'ninety-nine'

75 to 99 members.
