HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 104, L.D. 101, Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act to Expand Eligibility to Recipients of Supplemental Security Income."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3273, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 790, §3, is repealed.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 and 2 to be sections 2 and 3.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the eligibility limitation which appears in the law creating the state optional supplemental program to supplemental security income.
