COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 102, L.D. 109, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Designation of Anatomical Gifts on Motor Vehicle and Motorcycle Operators' Licenses."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 9th and 10th lines (7th and 8th lines of L.D.) the underlined words "if the gift is technically feasible, and if the donee has medical need for the gift" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words: 'and upon acceptance by the donee'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting in the 5th line (4th line of L.D.) after the underlined word "issued" the following underlined words: 'to a person 18 years of age or older at the time of issuance'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to provide that an anatomical gift would become effective after the death of the donor upon its acceptance by the donee and to provide that the statement provided for in section 2 of the bill being amended shall only appear on operators' licenses issued by the Secretary of State to adult persons who are 18 years of age or older on the date of issuance.
