STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Change the Statutory Term "Workmen's Compensation" to "Workers' Compensation".

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 39 MRSA, § 1, is amended to read:

§ 1. Short title

This chapter shall be known, and may be cited and referred to in proceedings and agreements thereunder, as "The Workmen's Workers' Compensation Act;" the phrase "this Act," as used in said chapter, refers thereto.

Sec. 2. Amendatory clause. Wherever in the Maine Revised Statutes and the Private and Special Laws of Maine the term "workmen's compensation" appears, it shall be changed to "workers' compensation."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will change the statutory term "workmen's compensation" to "workers' compensation".

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
