STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Require the Department of Transportation to Maintain the
Ferry Ramp at Frenchboro, Long Island Plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Ferry Landing at Frenchboro; authorized. The Department of Transportation is directed to maintain and repair as part of the state highway system the ferry ramp at Frenchboro, Long Island Plantation. The ramp may be reconstructed from time to time as in the judgment of the department is necessary and the expense of reconstruction shall be paid from funds available for the construction of state highways.

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$20,000 to the Department of Transportation for the fiscal year 1975-76 to carry out the purpose of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

All Other	\$20,000

Any balances shall not lapse but shall be carried forward from year to year to be expended for the same purpose.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated by the Department of Transportation that approximately \$20,000 will be required to bring the Frenchboro ferry landing up to state standards for 10-ton capacity.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act requires the Department of Transportation to assume the maintenance of the ferry ramp at Frenchboro.
