AN ACT Relating to Emergency Call Facilities on the Maine Turnpike.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. Maine Turnpike; emergency call facilities.** The Maine Turnpike Authority shall erect and maintain emergency call facilities or boxes at one-mile intervals along alternate sides of the turnpike from York to Augusta. Such facilities shall be erected by December 31, 1976.

**Sec. 2. Application.** If, prior to the effective date of this Act, the Maine Turnpike is transferred to the State of Maine, such facilities shall be erected by the State Department of Transportation within a time limit to be established by the Governor.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to provide emergency call boxes along the roadside of the Maine Turnpike in order that help may be called when needed at the earliest possible time.
