**AN ACT Designating Head of Tide on the Union River under the Atlantic
Sea Run Salmon Commission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 3605 is enacted to read:

§ 3605. Head of tide Union River

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, for the purposes of this chapter, head of tide on the Union River, Hancock County, shall be designated as that point where the highway bridge on U. S. Route 1 crosses the river in the City of Ellsworth.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to designate the head of tide on the Union River at the highway bridge at the City of Ellsworth for purposes of administering the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission Law.
