COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 51, L.D. 132, Bill, "AN ACT to Require that Newly Constructed or Reconstructed Public Buildings be made Accessible to the Physically Handicapped."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 1 the following underlined sentence:

'Public housing for the purposes of this chapter shall include a minimum of 20 family units.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the next to the last line of section 2 (last line in L.D.) the underlined words "in the same direction"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to put a minimum on the number of units affected by this legislation.
