HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 51, L. D. 132, Bill, "AN ACT to Require that Newly Constructed or Reconstructed Public Buildings be made Accessible to the Physically Handicapped."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the underlined word "persons" in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) the underlined figure '5' and by inserting after the underlined word "persons" in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) the underlined words 'or more'

Statement of Fact

This amendment restricts the definition of "building" as used in the statutes relating to construction for the physically handicapped to structures or facilities constructed in whole or in part with state and federal funds and specifically intended as a place where 5 persons or more will be employed or for public housing. This amendment avoids the application of this bill to places where fewer than 5 persons are employed.
