COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 55, L.D. 136,
Bill, "AN ACT Prohibiting the Use of Motorboats
Powered by Internal Combustion Engines on
Nokomis Pond."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that
part designated "§2084." and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'§ 2084. --Nokomis Pond

No person, except a law enforcement official
or those assisting such officials, shall operate
a motorboat powered by an internal combustion
engine on Nokomis Pond, situated in the Towns of
Newport and Palmyra, Penobscot County.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the jurisdiction
of law enforcement official.
