STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Use of Motor Boats Powered by Internal Combustion Engines on Nokomis Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2084, is enacted to read:

§ 2084. —Nokomis Pond

No person, except an officer empowered to enforce this section, shall operate a motorboat powered by an internal combustion engine on Nokomis Pond, situated in the Towns of Newport and Palmyra, Penobscot County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Nokomis Pond is a public water supply. Because of its small size, continued use of internal combustion engines on the pond will damage the pond's usefulness as a public water supply. This Act will prohibit the use of motorboats powered by internal combustion engines on Nokomis Pond.
