AN ACT Relating to Discharge from Parole or Probation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

34 MRSA, § 1677-A is enacted to read:

§ 1677-A. Certification of discharge; restitution required

No person convicted of any crime involving damage to property or theft or misappropriation of any property shall be granted a certificate of discharge from probation or parole until that person has made complete restitution to the owner of the property of any loss of value caused by that crime.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will require anyone convicted of a crime against property to make restitution to the owner of the property before a discharge can be granted from parole or probation.
