AN ACT to Permit the Sale of Fireworks for 2 Weeks Before July 4th and on July 4th.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

8 MRSA, § 211, sub-§ 10, is enacted to read:

10. Sale within 2 weeks of July 4th and on July 4th. To the sale or use or explosion or causing to explode of any combustible or explosive composition or substance named in the first paragraph of this section which occurs within 14 days prior to July 4th or on July 4th. No person, partnership or corporation shall sell or resell any substance named in this section unless the Commissioner of Public Safety has issued him or it a license to sell those substances at a fee of \$5 per license. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall make and enforce any necessary rules and regulations pertaining to the issuance of a license under this subsection.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the sale of fireworks for 2 weeks before July 4th and on July 4th.
