COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 134, L.D. 150, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Enforcement of the Statutes on Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill (same in L.D.) by striking out all of sections 3, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 17.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections of the Bill to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove all references to the district court in this bill so that hearings on violations of the liquor laws by licensees will be heard before an Administrative Court Judge, instead of a District Court Judge.
