IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of County Treasurer of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA, § 2, 3rd ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 3, is further amended to read:

Aroostook County: County commissioners, \$2,003; except that one member of the board, designated by the board as chief administrative officer, shall receive \$7,235; clerk of courts, \$8,967; county treasurer, \$3,896 \$5,000; sheriff, \$8,348; register of deeds, northern district, \$7,235; southern district, \$7,235; judge of probate, \$6,122; register of probate, \$5,565;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this Act is to increase the salary of the County Treasurer of Aroostook County which is presently not commensurate with the existing workload or other county treasurers doing comparable work.
