SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 110, L.D. 156, Bill, "AN ACT Designating the Bureau of Taxation as the State Revenue Bureau and to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Property

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT to Clarify the State Tax Assessor's Authority to Delegate Duties.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'36 MRSA §52, first sentence is amended to read:

The State Tax Assessor shall have the power to distribute the duties given to him or to the Bureau of Taxation among such persons or divisions in said bureau as he may deem necessary for economy and efficiency in administration and may add to or eliminate the number of such divisions and may employ such deputies, assistants and employees as may be necessary, subject to the Personnel Law.'

Statement of Fact

The new language is intended to make clear the authority for the State Tax Assessor to delegate responsibility.
