COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 145, L. D. 163, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Grants-in-aid for Construction and Maintenance of Public Facilities for Boats."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'When such grants-in-aid are made to others, within the boundaries of an organized town, it shall be with concurrence of the municipal officers of the community.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment considers the community problem but also allows the bureau some leeway to work with landowners in unorganized towns.
