IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Permit the Advertising of Prescription Prices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA, § 2204-D, is enacted to read:

§ 2204-D. Advertisements permitted

Any pharmacist shall be permitted to advertise to the public the current retail prices with that pharmacist charges for prescription drugs. Such advertising shall be subject to reasonable regulation by the Commissioner of Health and Welfare.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit advertising of prescription drug prices.
