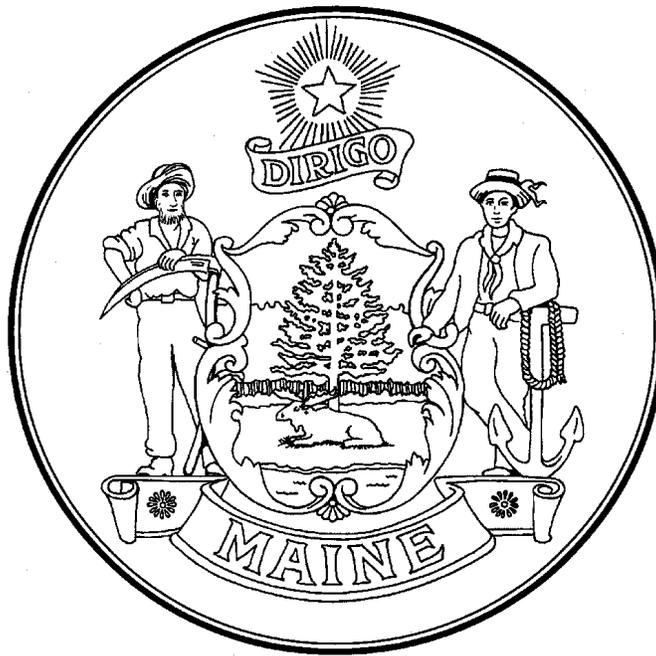

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Operation of Motorcycles or Motor Driven Cycles over
the Land of Another.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA, § 2189, is enacted to read:

§ 2189. Off-highway operation of motor driven cycles

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorcycle or motor driven cycle over the land of another unless the landowner has expressly granted him permission. Whoever violates this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for 30 days.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to prohibit to the users of trail bikes access of the land of another without express permission.
