RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for the Maintenance of Ocean Beach at Belfast.

Appropriation; maintenance of ocean beach. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$30,000 to the City of Belfast, Waldo County, to aid in the cost of cleaning, maintaining and improving the municipal ocean beach at the Belfast City Park in Belfast. The breakdown shall be as follows:
