COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 179, L. D. 196, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Laws Relating to the State Board for Registration of Architects."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the 6th line (same in L.D.) the words "previous to his" and inserting in place thereof the following '~~previous-to-his~~ prior to'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) the underlined figure "\$50" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$35'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the 3rd line (2nd line in L.D.) the word "he" and inserting in place thereof the following 'he'

Further amend said Bill in section 8 by striking out in the last line (same in L.D.) the word "he" and inserting in place thereof the following 'he'

Further amend said Bill in section 15 by striking out in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) the underlined words "to be fixed by the board" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'not to exceed \$200'; and by striking out in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) the words "to him" and inserting in place thereof the following '~~to-him~~'; and by striking out in the 13th line (11th line in L.D.) the word "his" and inserting in place thereof the following 'his'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to limit the increase in per diem for the board to \$35 instead of \$50, to limit the board's discretion in fixing

fees for nonresident architects, to remove discriminatory language and to clarify the language of the bill.
