COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 165, L.D. 199, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Vocational Rehabilitation Services to Those Persons who are Deaf or Who Have Impaired Hearing."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "D-1" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'D-1. Interpreting and other specific services necessary to meet the unique needs of those persons who are deaf or who have impaired hearing. These services shall include the aid of qualified personnel and interpreters who can relate to and communicate on an effective and meaningful basis with persons who are deaf or have impaired hearing.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to insure that interpreter services will be provided to the deaf and hearing impaired.
