COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " ^A " to H.P. 162, L.D. 205, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Penalty for Premeditated Animal Fights."

Amend said Bill in the 4th line after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) by inserting after the word and punctuation "promotes," the underlined words and punctuation 'or attends,'

Further amend said Bill in the 7th line after the amending clause (6th line in L.D.) by inserting after the word "not" the underlined words and figure 'less than \$200 nor'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include any one who attends such an event within the purview of this statute and to put more teeth into the penalty provision by mandating a fine of not less than \$200.
