STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Reduce the Maximum Allowable Height for Outdoor Advertising Near State Highways to Twenty-five Feet.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA, § 2716, sub-§ 2, \P D, sub- \P (1), div. (c), as last amended by PL 1973, c. 190, § 5, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

(c) Maximum height: 25 feet;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will require that all outdoor advertising near state highways, including embellishments on that advertising, be no higher than 25 feet.
