SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT
"A" to H.P. 154, L.D. 209, Bill, "AN ACT
Authorizing the Department of Environmental
Protection to License Privately-owned Septic
Waste Disposal Sites."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after
the underlined word and punctuation "located."
in the last line, before the Statement of
Fact, the following underlined sentences:

'Any private site which has been approved by the
Department of Environmental Protection prior
to the effective date of this Act shall be
subject to review for approval or disapproval
by the municipality in which it is located.
The municipality or the municipal officers
authorized to act for the municipality, after
hearing, shall approve any such private site if it
finds that the site does not constitute a hazard
to the health or safety of the residents of the
municipality. Such approval or disapproval shall
be made within 90 days after the effective date
of this Act. If the municipality disapproves the
location of such private site, it shall notify
the Department of Environmental Protection which
shall notify the site owner or operator that his
approval has been revoked. If the municipality
does not take action within 90 days after the
effective date of this Act such inaction shall
constitute approval.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides a standard for approval
or disapproval, provides a review by municipal
officers or municipalities of presently licensed
private sites and requires review and approval or
disapproval to be given within a reasonable time.
