SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 74, L. D. 214,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Permit All-day Hunting of Deer  
on Sunday by Maine Residents."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the  
last paragraph before the Statement of Fact  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. Sunday hunting of deer permitted for  
Maine residents. Maine residents may hunt deer  
from sunrise until sunset on Sundays which fall  
within the 1976 open season on deer in the  
northern zone.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow  
Sunday hunting for a trial period of one season  
in a limited area to determine statistical  
data as to the extent of pressure created by  
allowing hunting on Sunday.
