## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Reduce Registration Fee for Snow Traveling Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 1972, 3rd and 4th sentences, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 613, § 2, are further amended to read:

The Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized to register and assign a registration number to all snowmobiles, upon application and payment of an annual fee of \$10 \$5 by the owner. The resident registration fee shall be credited as follows: \$3 of each fee shall be credited to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game and \$7 \$2 of each fee shall be credited to the Bureau of Parks and Recreation and \$6 of each fee shall be annually distributed to the municipality of the owner's residence as shown on his registration certificate.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to remove that part of the registration fee for snow traveling vehicles which is paid to the municipalities due to the fact that municipalities in general do nothing in turn with the revenue to provide for the sport.
