AN ACT Relating to the State-wide Open Deer Season.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

¹² MRSA, § 2353, last 2 paragraphs, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 403, § 17, are amended to read:

It is provided that the commissioner is authorized to shorten the open season on deer ~~in any area of the State~~ statewide, providing such determination is made and published prior to September 1st of any year.

If in the opinion of the commissioner an immediate emergency action is necessary due to adverse weather conditions or severe hunting pressure, he may terminate the open season on deer at any time ~~in any area~~.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for a uniform open season for deer hunting.
