HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 185, L.D. 233, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow a Trade-in Credit on the Sales Tax on Boats."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting at the end, before the period, the following:

'and to Exempt from the Sales Tax Goods Manufactured in Maine which are Sold in Maine'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

- 'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§35 is enacted to read:
- 35. Goods manufactured in Maine. Sales of all goods manufactured in Maine which are sold in Maine.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'

Fiscal Note

It is estimated that passage of this amendment would result in a loss of revenue of millions of dollars annually.

Statement of Fact

This amendment will stimulate the economy of Maine and encourage Maine people to purchase increased quantities of goods manufactured in Maine.
