RESOLVE, to Reimburse Virginia A. Brann of Windsor for Motor Vehicle Damage Due to State Construction.

Virginia A. Brann; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$211 to be paid to Virginia A. Brann of Windsor for damage to her motor vehicle due to state construction.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to compensate Virginia A. Brann for damage to her 1971 Chevrolet which happened while her car was parked in the Motor Vehicle Registration parking lot at Augusta on November 16, 1972. A crowbar slipped from the hands of workmen for the State who were taking down a fence and the bar went through the grille and air conditioner of her car, causing \$211 worth of damage.
