STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase Salary of Clerk of Courts of Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA, § 2, 16th ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 3, is further amended to read:

Washington County: County commissioners, \$2,003; chairman, \$2,337; clerk of courts, \$5,787 \$7,300; county treasurer, \$5,009; sheriff, \$6,956; register of deeds, \$5,787; judge of probate, \$6,344; register of probate, \$5,787;

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1975.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the Clerk of Courts of Washington County from \$5,787 to \$7,300. This amount is necessary to bring the salary of this position into a proper prospective with comparable positions both within and without this county.
