COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 202, L.D. 247,
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Exemption of Hair-
dressers Holding Booth Licenses from Eligibility
for Unemployment Compensation."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of
the last line before the Statement of Fact and
before the period, the following underlined words:

if operated under a booth rental agreement or
other rental agreement'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exclude
from the definition of "employment" services
performed by individuals who are hairdressers
renting facilities in hairdressing establishments.
