COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A "to H.P. 204, L.D. 249,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Vehicle Operators Wear-
ing a Radio Headset."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of
the last paragraph, before the statement of fact,
the following new sentence:

'This paragraph shall not prohibit the use of
audio receiving devices by applicants during a
driver's examination when so directed by driver
license examining officials of the Motor Vehicle
Division.'

Statement of Fact

Current motorcycle examining procedure directs
the applicant through the road examination by horn
sounds which has resulted in numerous public com-
plaints. An alternative to this procedure is the
use of a radio communication device by the examiner,
which is currently being considered by the Motor
Vehicle Division.
