SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 84, L.D. 255, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Ballots Containing Improper Write-in Votes."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first line
after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'21 MRSA §925, sub-§2, §§ D and E are enacted to read:'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'E. Improper location of mark. If a voter fails to mark
his ballot so that some part of the cross or check mark
is within the proper square, the mark is ineffective and
his vote for the candidate or question concerned must not
be counted.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies existing law, which law was placed
in an ambiguous position as the result of an erroneous opinion
of the Attorney General.
