STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Repeal the Requirements that Assessors Conduct Annual Inventories of Births, Beekeepers and Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 7 MRSA, § 2503 is repealed.

Sec. 2. 7 MRSA, § 3401, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 788, § 31, is repealed.

Sec. 3. 7 MRSA, § 3402, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 625, § 43, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 3402. Copies of law posted

The commissioner shall seasonably forward to the clerks of the several municipalities copies of sections 3451, 3452, 3501 and 3701 to 3703, and each clerk shall annually, at least 20 days before the first day of April, post said copies in the usual places for posting notices of the annual municipal or town elections.

Sec. 4. 22 MRSA, § 2762 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal statutory provisions which are no longer utilized. The Department of Agriculture no longer uses the list of all persons keeping bees or the list of all dogs 6 months old or over. The vital records section of the Department of Health and Welfare receives a record of all births from each municipality which is furnished to the municipalities by the hospitals.
