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**AN ACT** to Authorize the Issue of an Additional Pair of Specially Designated License Plates to Maine Members of the United States Senate and House.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA, § 193, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 2, is amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read:

Upon request by a Maine Member of the United States Senate or by a Maine Member of the United States House of Representatives, the Secretary of State shall issue an additional pair of specially designed number plates for a 2nd designated motor vehicle owned or controlled by that Member.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Maine Senators and Representatives often travel by airplane back and forth between Washington, D. C. and Maine and therefore, they often maintain 2 cars, one in Washington and one in Maine. This bill will allow the Secretary of State to issue them an additional set of specially designed number plates for their cars upon request.
