STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Provide Elected District Attorneys and Assistant District Attorneys with Fringe Benefits.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 106th Legislature provided a system of full-time district attorneys and assistant district attorneys to serve as elected officers of the State; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to fund necessary insurance and retirement benefits which are not otherwise provided for the first 6 months; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$24,847 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
