**AN ACT to Require the Executive Council to Inform the  
Governor and the Legislature of its Activities.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

2 MRSA, § 53 is enacted to read:

**§ 53. Minutes**

**The Executive Council shall keep written minutes of all business transacted at its meetings and after each meeting shall forward a copy of these minutes to the Governor and to each Member of the Legislature.**

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This Act will require the Executive Council to provide the Governor and each Member of the Legislature with a summary of the activities of each Council meeting.
