AN ACT Establishing the Town of Southport in Lincoln
County as a Wildlife Management Area.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA, § 2154, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 739, § 5-A, is further amended by adding at the end the following:

Southport: The Town of Southport in Lincoln County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will designate the Town of Southport a Wildlife Management Area.

The Town of Southport at its annual town meeting of March 5, 1973, has voted to request the Legislature to make it a Wildlife Management Area.
