STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing the Annual Payment to the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law Library of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

27 MRSA, § 224, 4th ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 540, § 4, is amended to read:

Cumberland, \$7,000 \$10,000 which shall be paid to the treasurer of the Cumberland Bar Association for the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law Library;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The last increase in the appropriation for the Nathan and Henry B. Cleaves Law Library was in 1973 when the amount was increased from \$5,000 to \$7,000. The expenses of the library have continued to increase due in great part to increased usage by governmental personnel. Because of the increased cost of books, an adjustment must be made in the appropriation in order to keep the library collection up-to-date and to provide library service for the judiciary and other court related personnel.
