STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Clarify Directional Signs Indicating Coastal Route at Exit 9 on the Maine Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA, § 1201, sub-§ 7 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

7. Falmouth-Coastal Route 1. Such signs shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike at points southerly no more than 2 miles, 1 mile and at exit 9 and shall be worded as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify directional signs on the Maine Turnpike at Exit 9 for those who seek to travel the coastal route from that point.
