STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Permit Primary Assessing Districts to Employ Part-time Assessors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA, § 303, sub-§ 3, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 620, § 10, is amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read:

Nothing in the standards promulgated by the State Tax Assessor shall prevent a primary assessing district from employing a part-time or shared assessor so long as the district and the assessor meet the other requirements as so promulgated, and so long as the standards of assessment quality in that district are maintained at a level 20% above those as determined by the State Tax Assessor for all other districts.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will allow certain municipalities to qualify as single municipality assessing districts while still employing a part-time tax assessor.
