IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Wholesale Deliveries of Malt
Beverages and Table Wine on Election Day.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA, § 4, first ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 643, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

Except that wholesalers of malt beverages and table wine may make deliveries to retail licensees on the day of holding a general election or state-wide primary.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits wholesale deliveries of malt beverages and table wine on election day and thus allows retail licensees to replenish their stock in the normal course of business without any possible interference with the election process.
