HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 262, L. D. 309, Bill, "AN ACT Eliminating the Need for a License to Sell Prophylactic Rubber Goods."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT Relating to the Licensing and Sale of Prophylactic Rubber Goods.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1131 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§1131. Sale

No retail seller, except a pharmacy, of sanitary or prophylactic rubber or other articles for the prevention of venereal disease shall publicly display such articles. Such articles may be sold by vending machines in rest rooms in buildings to which the public customarily has access.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §§1132 - 1143 are repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the bill and to change the title so that it relates to the licensing and sale of prophylactic rubber goods.
